**City Administrator Long** stated as the Council met last time there was a discussion and a Resolution adopted to create a new safety coordinator position. As a part of the second portion was the concept was to take one of the existing staff that was in the

building department and transfer that person to the new position. The concept was to take an existing plumbing inspector and reclassify them as a plumbing inspector/deputy building inspector so that they would be able to do both titles. The City Council also passed an ordinance last meeting that allows for the Building Inspectors to also inspect plumbing and the Plumbing Inspector to also inspect building. As was discussed at the last meeting all of these code officers are all trained and they all have the same exact credentials in terms of education with the State Education Department, the Department of State and their annual renewals. Building Inspector Gary Beck is here to talk about the specifics of that as well. Primarily this is a financial resolution transferring money from one line to another

**Councilmember Johnson** asked what the duties of the Safety Coordinator are.

**City Administrator Long** responded that the Safety Coordinator is responsible for doing the training for all of the competent persons within DPW garage, and all of the different divisions, the water and sewer, parks. The City of Poughkeepsie is required to comply with all of the OSHA requirements as well as the FASH regulations. We have had several accidents over the years as discussed at last meeting we try to implement a safety committee ways to reduce risk and make it a safer environment for everyone. The Safety Coordinator will be the point person and try to make sure that everyone follows the correct steps.

**Building Inspector Beck** stated that everyone has been trained and certified and receive the same amount of training and there will be cross training. We have eliminated one step by moving the Plumbing Inspector to the Deputy Building Inspector that review process will be taken out of the picture. They will be doing all inspections so if someone is out they will not have to wait to have an inspection done.

**Councilmember Herman** made a motion to place R10-57 back on the floor, **Councilmember Parise** seconded the motion.

**INTRODUCED BY COUNCILMEMBER HERMAN**

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Development has recommended the elimination of the position of Plumbing Inspector and the duties of the Plumbing Inspector be transferred to the Building Inspector; and

**WHEREAS**, the duties of the Plumbing Inspector can be carried out by the Building Inspector and the Deputy Building Inspectors; and

**WHEREAS**, the Director of Development further recommends the addition of another Deputy Building Inspector who will share in the functions of code enforcement and review as well as plumbing inspections; and

**WHEREAS**, these proposed changes will not result in a funding increase in the 2010 Budget, but will require the amendment of the 2010 budget to reflect the proposed changes; and

**WHEREAS**, the Common Council of the City of Poughkeepsie has determined that this resolution constitutes a Type II action as defined by the New York State Environmental Quality Review Act and 6 NYCRR Part 617,

**NOW, THEREFORE,**

**BE IT RESOLVED**, that the 2010 Budget for the City of Poughkeepsie is hereby amended as follows:
