
Gus Kazolias- 47 Noxon Street- submitted a letter to Council

Ken Stickle- Catherine Street- stated before the Council that he agrees with Councilmember Johnson; should be paying city taxes. Department heads should be required to vote and pay taxes in the city. He stated that the city of Poughkeepsie has firefighters that live 30 miles outside of the city of Poughkeepsie.

Andrew Tkazyik-45 Dutchess Avenue- stated before the Council that Rich DuPilka is a very dedicated employee to the City of Poughkeepsie. Rich deserves the job no matter where he lives.

Chris Petsas-8 Talmadge Street- stated before the Council that he did not want to lose Rich DuPilka; does not believe the administration code should change. He stated that the change will allow tax payers to fund a position where the employee resides outside of the city border. He stated that he fully understands the rush, nature of this change; the city does not want to lose City Engineer DuPilka. He stated that Rich DuPilka did a great job as city engineer. He stated that he does not think that the city administrative code should be changed for one individual. He stated that it is a dangerous unprecedented move. If this change is approved other city department heads will to press a case that they do not have to live within city limits. He stated that he is sadly confident that the Common Council will vote for this change; bad government and bad for Poughkeepsie.
