

SANITATION & RECYCLING REMINDERS

BULK SERVICE PROGRAM

The Bulk Service Program is an opportunity for City residents to drop off household bulk items at the Transfer Station at no cost. The program is available during regular Transfer Station hours of operation. The program runs twice a year, May and September. Curbside pick-up of bulk items is also available for a nominal fee.

2016 bulk drop-off dates:

Monday May 9, 2016 – Saturday May 14, 2016

Monday September 12, 2016 – Saturday September 17, 2016

2016 curbside pick-up dates:

Wednesday May 11, 2016

Wednesday September 14, 2016

Bulk drop-off guidelines:

- Open to all City residents.
- No tipping fee for bulk items.
- 1 pick-up truck load per City resident. (4'x8' truck bed with no sidewalls)
- Photo ID and proof of residency required. (utility bill, cable bill or telephone bill)
- Resident must accompany the bulk items
- Prohibited items: Construction debris, yard debris, propane tanks, recyclables and hazardous waste. A fee will be charged for the disposal of hazardous waste items such as: air conditioners, refrigerators, freezers, appliances etc.

Curbside pick-up guidelines:

- Curbside pick-up fee \$35.00
- Fee is waived for disabled residents and residents 65 years and older.
- 5 bulk items maximum per address.

Curbside pick-up is scheduled by appointment only. For additional information or to schedule a curbside pick-up, please call DPW Dispatch at (845)451-4111.

YARD DEBRIS

The curbside pick-up of yard debris and bagged leaves occurs every Wednesday from April through November. Yard debris collection will be suspended during the weeks in which sanitation and recycling collection are being collected on Wednesday due to the Sanitation Holiday Collection schedule. Yard debris includes small branches no thicker than two inches in diameter and cut into three-foot sections. Yard debris should be placed at the curb no earlier than 5:00 pm on Tuesday evenings. Yard debris must be placed in bio-degradable paper bags, a clean garbage can, and/or bundled and tied.
